

# Topic 1: Movies



The history of film spans over a hundred years, from the latter part of the 19th century to the present day and beyond. Motion pictures developed from a carnival innovation to one of the most important tools of communication and entertainment, and mass media in the 20th century. Motion picture films have had consequences on the arts, technology, and politics.

## 1 ► Evaluation of our diagrams

After evaluating our survey, we came to the result, that most pupils like comedy movies. As you can see in the first diagram, 14 of 62 (→ everybody was allowed to vote two times) votes were for comedy movies. Directly after this there are the serials with 11 votes. On the third place there are fantasy movies with 10 votes (like for example “Twilight”).

In the second diagram you can see, that “Saw” and “American Pie” are both on the first place with 4 of 26 votes. On the second place is the movie “P.S. I love you” with 3 votes.

## 2 ► Defining relative clauses

### “Rules”

The relative pronouns are:

who	→	for persons and pets with a name
which	→	for things or animals
that	→	for things, animals, or persons
whose	→	belonging for persons, things and animals (dessen)
whom	→	for persons (is used as an object)

→ You can leave them out, when the relative pronoun is the object of the sentence!

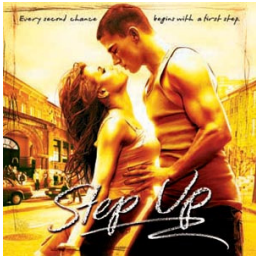
