In 1895, an Italian scientist called Marconi invented the Radio.

The most important features of the radio are audio recording, transmission and radio reception.

There are many parallels between the radio and the telephone. So the telephone must be invented before the radio.

In 1857, Marconi succeeded in a transmission of about 5 km and in 1901, he managed a transmission over the Atlantic Sea. Today the Radio is a very important source of music and information.

## Indirect speech (Reported Speech)

---

Indirect speech refers to a sentence reporting what someone has said. It is almost always used in spoken English.

Present I <b>m</b> a teacher.	Past He said he <b>was</b> a teacher.
Present perfect I <b>ve been</b> to France three times.	Past perfect He said he <b>had been</b> to France three times.
Simple Past I <b>bought</b> a new car.	Past perfect She said she <b>had bought</b> a new car.
Past perfect The play <b>had started</b> when I arrived.	Past perfect <b>NO CHANGE POSSIBLE</b>
Present progressive I <b>m going to</b> school.	Past progressive He said he <b>was going to</b> school.
Past progressive I <b>was playing</b> the game.	Perfect progressive He said he <b>had been playing</b> the game.
will- Future I <b>will meet</b> her.	would + verb She said she <b>would meet</b> her.

Nothing changes if the reporting verb is in the present!

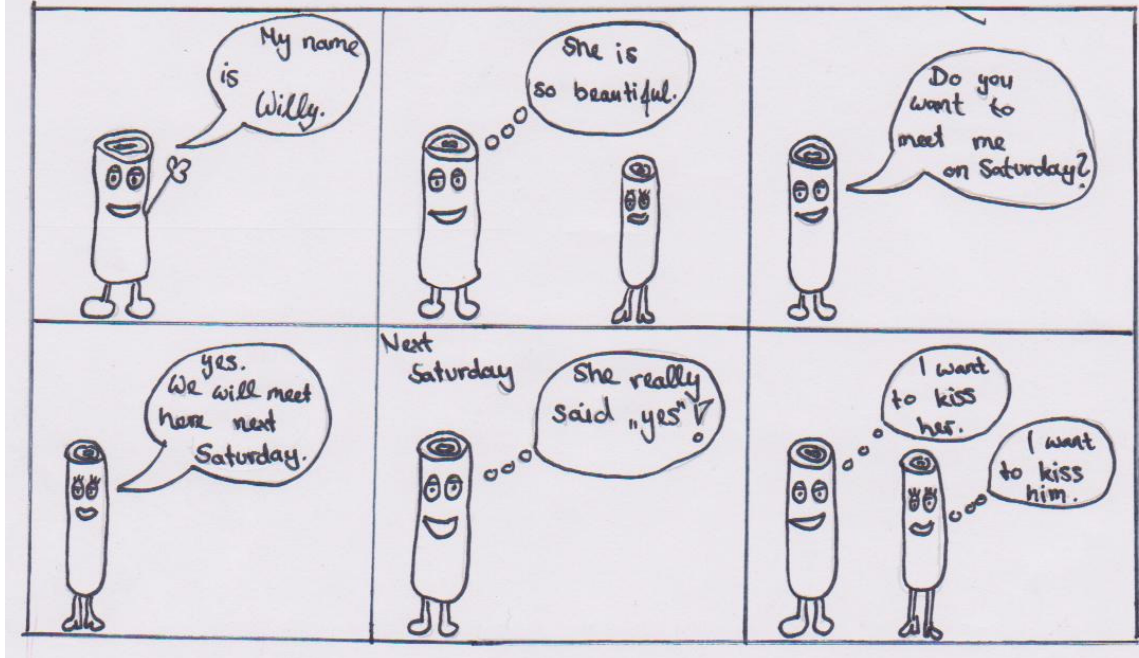
Will, can, shall and may changes to would, could, should and might!

Would, should, could and might stay the same!

## Changing of the adverbs

<b>This (evening)</b>	That (evening)
<b>Today/ this day</b>	That day
<b>These (days)</b>	Those (days)
<b>now</b>	then
<b>(a week) ago</b>	(a week) before
<b>Last weekend</b>	The weekend before
<b>here</b>	there
<b>Next (week)</b>	following (week)
<b>tomorrow</b>	the next/following day
